No declarations were made.

Police Scotland Report

The Police were unable to attend the meeting as they were not on shift but had submitted a report which had been circulated. There were various assaults, break-ins and speeding fines issued. Vandalism at the Golf Ball at Balado was noted.

Treasurer's Report

Grant application (for CAP) has gone to PKC but has not been actioned yet.

CAP

Minutes from the last meeting had been circulated. Another meeting was taking place on 9th September. CAP event on Saturday 20 September. Volunteers were required.

Parks & Recreation

E Gilmour had sent various emails to PKC Greenspace but these had not been answered. The person in charge is thought to be off work. DC said he would follow up. ACTION DC

Planning Matters

CCIIr Willsher advised that PKC Planning had resubmitted their drawing re 6 x industrial units backing on to MacDuff Place and were now retaining the belt of trees in question. However, the MoP pointed out that the 2m high security fence was now on the outside of the trees rather than on the inside, and she would retain her objection to the application believing it to be an interruption to a wildlife corridor as well as unsightly. It was voted to keep the KCC objection live on those grounds.

BCA Planning Application Notice

Two public events scheduled for 17 Sept and 15 October where public can speak to the developers. It was thought that the CAP event would be a good place for any community objections/thoughts to be brought together. DC noted the importance of retaining the road to the pier.

No news on flood protection enquiry. A hearing must take place because of objections to the works. **Green Issues**

Cllr Reports

Green Living Fund – CC said it was not very clear who could apply on behalf of whom. Further research to be undertaken.

DC: CIF funding (previously decided by Kinross-shire committee) now going to a participatory budgeting session where public vote on priorities. Larger groups will apply and no doubt get funding.

There is £17,000 for Kinross-shire. It was suggested that smaller groups could possibly be united under one banner in order for them to have a chance at gaining a good proportion of votes. KCC will lead application for all those who may otherwise lose out.

Formation of a Development Trust would help with this sort of activity. Will be discussed at CAP. Funding is available to Development Trusts.

Road Safety: DC noted the improvements required for crossings at Station Rd/Davies Park and Sainsburys/P&R. A new bus shelter should have been delivered. Kinross seems to get the least done in P&K, he is meeting with roads maintenance and road safety teams to find out why standard of repairs so much worse here than in Perth and to push for 1st time permanent repairs (not temporary ones). Road Safety have said they have been busy with pavement parking/20mph signs/Destiny Bridge. DC notes that A977 is much busier than A93/A94!

MoP: Could we please arrange to have the 20mph sign at Renton Drive (10-12 houses) moved 2 lampposts down to where there are 60+ houses.

Streetlights soon to be repaired/replaced (yellow road markings all over Kinross noted).

Discussion on giving traffic from Milnathort priority at Station Road and creating a give-way for traffic coming from the South end of Kinross. Timescale would be long.

Car abandoned at Davies Park. Suggestion that car parking for 4 cars could be added by simply moving a bollard.

Cllr L McKay:

Bowton Road water issues at park still not resolved. the banking covered in weeds and water unseen. No signage that deep flowing water is hidden beneath. Local childminders have been raising the issue around safety.
